



Garden Markers

Please place a garden marker in the corner of your plot. This marker applies to the entire plot, tells section leaders and other gardeners what level of assistance you desire, and possibly your willingness to share produce.

If you see:

Red

Please don't touch my bed!

- Please don't take any produce.
- Assistance is neither desired nor required.

Yellow

One for me, one for a fellow.

- Weeding is rewarded by sharing up to 50%.
- Replace with RED after taking your share.

Green

Please take what you can glean.

- If it's ready, no need to ask.
- Weeding is appreciated.

Blue

Please water me, too!

- Please help care for my plot while away.
- Contact a section leader if you see issues.

Guidance:

- Treat a plot **WITHOUT** a marker the same as a Red marker.
- Blue is the only color marker which may be combined with others (Y/G/B).
- Replace a Yellow marker with a Red marker after you take up to 50% of ready produce. This ensures others won't take too much.
- Markers apply to the entire bed, not per plant. To be self-selective, use a red marker and share your extra produce at the next club or coffee meeting.
